#### CLASS SIZE

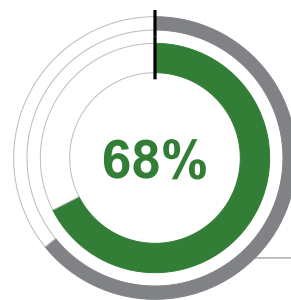
Median size of classes in core subjects.

Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

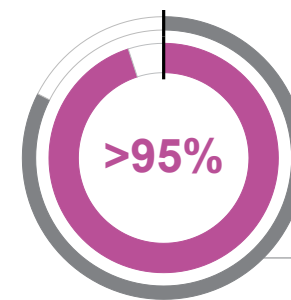

Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

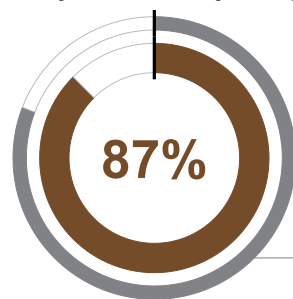

#### ON-TIME GRADUATION

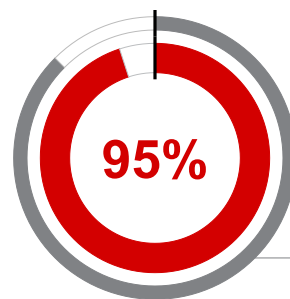

#### FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

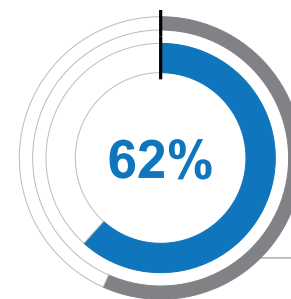
Students earning a high school diploma or GED within five years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2016-17 finishing in 2020-21.

### School Goals

Professional Learning Communities: our staff utilize Wednesday early release days to further develop and implement PLC's within our building and across levels within the district. 9th-grade success team: support all 9th graders in demonstrating behaviors and achieving outcomes academically and socially to maintain on-track to graduate status. MTSS Teams: gather, evaluate, and respond to data representing the whole student population, student subgroups, and individual students in order to ensure all students graduate.

### State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

SHS's effort to provide great customer service to all stakeholders comes from a core belief about having great relationships between staff and all students. SHS sets high expectations, removes barriers to success, and elevates the achievement of all students and our community. 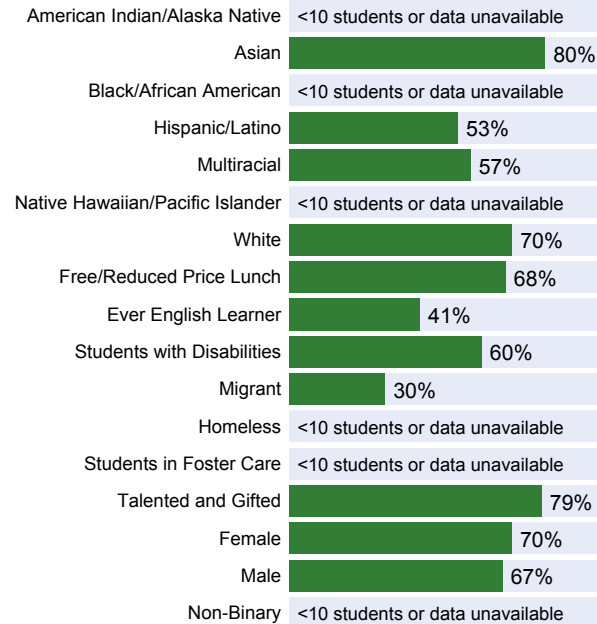

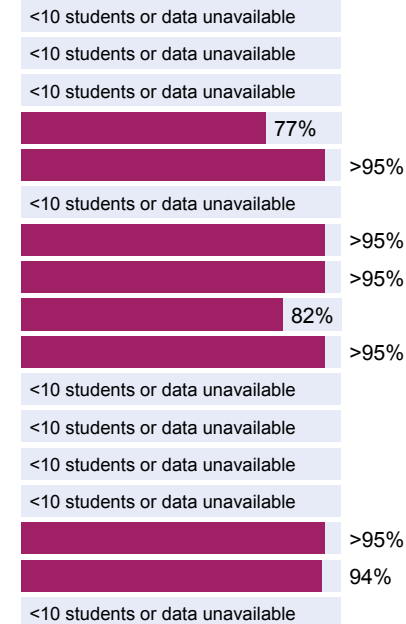

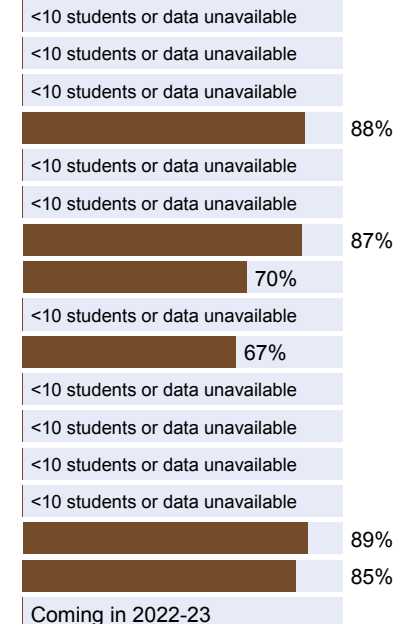
