### ACADEMIC UPDATES

- ❖ **We are so excited to start the 2018-19 school year!** Staff and students have taken a much needed break and will be ready to get the new year started.
  - **REGISTRATION** is August 28, 1-4pm and 5-7pm and August 29, 10am-12pm, 1-4pm, and 5-7pm
    - **New to the District?** New student registration is August 22-23 by Appointment, call 971-200-8005 to schedule an appointment.
    - **What to Expect at Registration:** Registration is an important step in preparing for the new school year. Students will be able to get a locker if they want, get school pictures taken (ASB card photos), and get their new school shirts. Fees such as the ASB fees and athletic fees can be paid during registration. It is also a great time to add money to lunch accounts.
    - **Fees:** ASB \$55, 2018-19 Yearbook \$55 (until Sept 1), Athletics \$175 (family cap of \$500 per year), \$1.75 breakfast/\$3.25 lunch
  - **FRESHMEN** start on **Tuesday, September 4.**
  - **ALL STUDENTS** return on **Wednesday, September 5.**
